



## **COLLEGE GOLF FELLOWSHIP REGIONAL ADVISORY TEAM LEADER QUALIFICATIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES**

In addition to the Qualities, Roles & Responsibilities and Commitment Level of a RAT Member:

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Most critical RAT team member and local staff's greatest champion of CGF.
- Motivational leader with a teachable spirit. He should be easy to follow and have the respect of the team. He should be skilled in organizational leadership and relationally connected in the community.
- Understands that the RAT is a team who supports and prays for the local staff, the ministry of CGF, and each other -- different from a corporate board that simply provides direction & oversees results.
- Qualified to be a potential candidate for the CGF National Board.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES (always coordinating with CGF staff)**

- Sets the tone and casts vision for the RAT
- Helps identify and train new RAT members keeping in view the ideal team structure:
  - 5-7 men you respect and enjoy being with who exhibit the CGF qualities of a RAT member
  - Proximity to where ministry is happening (i.e., campuses, golf teams, events, etc.)
  - Spread of ages and experience (i.e., business, ministry, non-profit, etc.)
- Initiates and oversees RAT team initiatives, annual planning, calendar, and meetings.
- Leads RAT fundraising efforts to achieve CGF staff annual goals.
- Helps RAT members set annual goals in the following critical areas of commitment: time, talent, treasure, and network / relationships.
- Periodically connects with CGF Executive Director and/or CGF Chairman of National Board for ongoing support and encouragement.
- Encourages CGF staff in recruiting and developing of future interns and staff.
- Trains and develops the RAT (i.e., initiate meetings with other high-functioning RATs to share ideas and encouragement, etc.).
